



INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

(TERMS OF COMPETITION)

Management

The **SLB – SportExcel International Junior Championship 2026** (hereinafter referred to as "The Tournament") shall be managed by a Tournament Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "The Committee") appointed by the **YAYASAN KECEMERLANGAN SUKAN MALAYSIA (SportExcel)**, whose decision on all matters shall be final

1. Venue & Date

Date: 6th – 8th October 2026

Venue: Glenmarie Golf & Country Club (Garden Course)

2. Format

The Championships shall be decided by stroke play over three rounds of 18 holes (**54 HOLES**) every category. There shall be **no cut-off** for the Championships.

Inter-Team Championship

- Teams consist of **4 players**.
- The **best 3 gross scores** from each round will count towards the team total.
- Open to **Boys and Girls – Group A & Group B only** (combined team category).

3. Ranking

World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR)

4. Number of Participants

Expected participation: 100 participants. The Organizing Committee will adjust the number of participants based on the actual number of registrations.

5. Eligibility & Age Requirements

The Championship is open to **BOYS GIRLS**, 11 to 18 years (under 19 years old) of age as of 6th Oct 2026

- BLUE (Boys A & B)
- WHITE (Girls A & B)
- RED (Boys C)
- YELLOW (Girls C)

8. Competition Rules and Methods

Groups A, B, and C will compete in **three** rounds of 18-holes stroke play. The player with the lowest total strokes will be ranked highest. In case of a tie for the first place in any group, a sudden-death playoff (For Group A & B only) will determine the winner. For other tied positions, the ranking will first be determined by the final round's score, with the lower score ranking higher. If still tied, the ranking will be determined by the score on the last nine holes (holes 10-18) of the final round, with the lower score ranking higher. If still tied, the ranking will be determined by a hole-by-hole countback starting from the 18th hole of the final round, with the lower score ranking higher. If still tied, a drawing of lots will decide the ranking.

9. Practice Round

Practice Round is on **5th Oct 2026, morning tee times only**. The course shall be closed to all players at 4pm.

The course may not be closed for practice rounds, thus please be mindful of your pace of play and golf etiquette as there may be other playing guests on the course.

Please call/email the club directly to book your tee time for Practice Round. You can book your tee time two weeks in advance. Charges for Practice Round are in Ringgit Malaysia (RM) and shall be paid directly to the club.

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Charges:

- **RM158.00 nett per player** (Green Fee, Twin-share buggy, Twin-share Caddie & Insurance)
- Surcharge for Single Ball is **RM117.00**
- Caddie Tips at a minimum of **RM100.00** per caddie per round (if two players share a caddie, then it's RM50.00 per player; if one player uses a caddie, then it's RM100.00 per player); **Caddie tips to be paid directly to the caddie**
- Additional buggy for follower (non-playing parent) is **RM148.00** per buggy.
- Parents playing with a player during Practice Round shall pay **RM354.00** nett for Twin-share

Note: Minimum 2 players but the club has the rights to merge to 4 players per flight.

Note: All players or non-players entering the course must be properly attired with golf attire.

10. Caddies on tournament days/Trolleys

- **All groups** to use buggy throughout
- Clubs Caddies and outside caddies are **ALLOWED**.
- For club caddy booking please contact Glenmarie Caddy Master (Mr. Paneer - +60129162539)
- Electrical motorized trolleys are **NOT ALLOWED**.

11. Spectators

- Tournament Rounds - **NO** Rental of buggies for spectators. Spectators are **Only Allowed** to walk on the **Buggy Track ONLY**
- Spectators are compulsory to purchase daily insurance.
- Spectators **HAVE TO** obtain a course pass to enter the course from the secretariat room.

12. Distance Measuring Device (DMD)

- A player may obtain distance information by using a device that **MEASURES DISTANCE ONLY** – (R&A) Rule – 4-3 a

13. PACE OF PLAY (Rule 5.6)

13.1) Time Allowed

Each hole has been given a maximum completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the hole. The maximum time allotted for the completion of 18 holes will be available prior to play. Please refer to the Tournament Notice Board. Please note that "Ready Golf" is encouraged.



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13.2) Definition of Out of Position

The first group and any group after a starter's gap will be "out of position" if at any time during the round, the group's cumulative time exceeds the time allowed for the number of holes played. Any following group will be considered "out of position" if it is more than the starting time interval behind the group in front and has exceeded the time allowed for the number of the holes played.

13.3) Procedure When Group Is Out of Position

If the decision is taken to time the group, each player in the group will be subject to individual timing by a Referee. Each player in the group will be advised that they are "out of position" and are being timed.

The maximum time allocated per shot is 40 seconds. 10 extra seconds are allowed for the first player to play:

- On the tee box
- On the subsequent shots: and
- On the putting green

The timing will start when a player has reached his ball, it is his turn to play and he is able to play without interference or distraction. On putting green, timing will start when the player has had a reasonable amount of time to lift, clean and replaced his ball, repair ball marks and move loose impediments on his line of putt. Time spent looking at the line from beyond the hole and/ or behind the ball will count as time taken for the next stroke.

Timing ceases when a group is either back in position in relation to the preceding group or within the allocated time for the holes played.

13.4) Penalty Of Breach of Condition

| 1 bad time | Player will be warned by the Rules Official and told that if he has a further bad time he will be penalized. |
| 2 bad times | Penalty of one stroke |
| 3 bad times | Further penalty of two strokes |
| 4 bad times | Disqualification |

If a group is "out of position" more than once during a round, the above procedure will apply on each occasion. Bad times and the applications of penalties in the same round will be carried forward until the Round is completed. A player will not be penalized if he has a second bad time before being advised of his earlier bad time.



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14. Score Cards

14.1) Scorecard collection will be at your starting hole.

14.2) Scorecard submission will be at the tournament room. (Beside Club's registration counter)

14.3) All competitors must submit their respective scorecard duly signed and counter signed by his/her marker as soon as possible after the completion of each round and in any event, not be later than 10 minutes after the completion of each round.

14.4) A scorecard is deemed to be submitted the moment the competitor leaves the scoring area with both feet.

15. E-Scoring

15.1) E-scoring is enforced to improve accuracy and transparency, enable real-time leaderboards and align junior events with international tournament standards. Each player is responsible for entering hole-by-hole scores correctly into the e-scoring system and verifying scores with their marker after each hole or immediately after the round.

Electronic scoring is mandatory and forms part of the Player Code of Conduct under Rule 1.2b.

15.2) E-Scoring Requirements

- E-scoring is compulsory for all players
- All players must bring a mobile phone, power bank, and active SIM card
- Local players must ensure mobile data is switched on
- International players must ensure data roaming is activated
- Scores must be entered hole by hole using the E-Scoring system
- Caddies are allowed to key in the scores

16. Competition Closed

16.1) The Championship shall be deemed to have closed when the 1st of the prizes has been awarded to the winners.

17. Ties

17.1) In the event of a tie for the **overall champion** (Blue & White), the winner shall be decided by a sudden death playoff on the hole to be decided by the Committee until the winner is decided by elimination. The purpose of the play-off is to decide the WINNER for the championship only.



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17.2) For other placing the winner shall be decided by a count-back and also the both event of a tie for any other placings, the tie shall be decided by a count-back on the final day score card in the following order:

- Last 18 holes.
- Last 9 holes.
- Last 6 holes.
- Last 3 holes and finally last hole.

If the tie is still undecided, it shall be decided by lot.

19. Confirmation of Participation

Note: Players who have submitted the entry together with the payment will have receive a confirmation of payment email. SportExcel will go through all the player's criteria and then will send a confirmation email on their participation. If a player's application is rejected, due to non-conforming criteria, the entry fee will be refunded within 14 days from the closing date of the tournament.

20. Registration

Players Registration will be at the Tournament office – (beside the bag drop) (starts at 6.00am). Please show your QR code to the person at the registration for attendance purpose. Player's QR code will be sent to their email that they have registered for this tournament after player have been confirmed.

21. Registration Requirements

All participants must register at the designated time and location. Late registration will be considered as withdrawals. Participants must present valid identification at tournament registration and sign the "Disclaimer," "Health Declaration," and other relevant documents.

- **Overall Champion**
Overall Champion of the blue and white tee will receive a prize.
- **Inter-Team Championship**
Top 3 team
- Certificate of Participation & Excellence will be awarded.

The winners of the **Boys' 15–18** and **Girls' 15–18** categories will each receive an exemption spot to compete in the **2026 NextGen Amateur Tour World Final** in Melbourne, Australia.

- **Venue:** Metropolitan Golf Club, Melbourne
- **Practice round:** 14 October 2026
- **Format:** Three rounds over two days
- **Status:** World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR) event

2027 Asian Development Tour Exemption

In addition, the **Boys' Blue Tee Overall Champion** will receive an exemption spot to compete in a selected **2027 Asian Development Tour (ADT)** tournament.

The specific ADT tournament, including its date, venue and participation details, will be announced at a later date.

27. Dress Code

Smart Golf Attire at all times. Slippers, sandals, and round neck T-shirts are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** at the Course and Club Premise and the Prize Presentation.

29. Others

- **Withdrawal:**

If a player who has obtained participation qualification cannot participate for any reason, they must send a withdrawal application to sportexcelinternational@gmail.com by **11:59 pm on 3rd Oct 2026**. Late withdrawal applications will be invalid, and the Organizing Committee will supplement participants as necessary. If a player fails to follow the stipulated leave and withdrawal procedures within the specified time, the Organizing Committee will not refund the participation fee and may impose a suspension penalty depending on the severity of the situation.



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- **Waiver and Release**

By registering to play or playing in this championship, player acknowledges and fully understands that his/her participation in the event may involve the risk of injury, including the possibility of serious injury or death, not only from his/her own actions, but also from the action or inaction of others, the condition of the premises, or the failure of the equipment used. Player knowingly agrees to assume all such risks, known and unknown, and assume full responsibility for his/her participation and waive and forever release the Organizers, the Committee, the Sponsors, and the Host Club from and against any and all liabilities, claims, expenses or causes of action of any kind or nature whatsoever, arising out of or relating to his/her participation in the event. Furthermore, player also recognizes that the Committee have the right and responsibility to record the event through video and still photography of any and all participants. Player grants permission that such photography may be used for event publicity, public information, or any other promotional use that falls within the Committee activity.

- **Health Requirements for Participants:**

Participants must have the ability to participate in a golf competition (including good physical condition, skilled techniques, and the ability to adapt to the difficulty and climate of the competition). Participants, their parents, and other accompanying persons are fully

responsible for their health status. The following patients should not register for the competition: patients with congenital heart disease and rheumatic heart disease, patients with hypertension and cerebrovascular disease, patients with myocarditis and other heart diseases, patients with coronary artery disease and severe arrhythmia, and patients with

other diseases that are not suitable for sports. The event organizers are not responsible for any accidents caused by the above reasons, and the consequences shall be borne by the participants and their parents.

- **Appeals**

Arbitrators, chief referees, and referees will be uniformly appointed by the Organizing Committee, which will establish an arbitration Committee. If players have objections to matters other than the "Rules of Golf," they must submit an appeal letter within 10 minutes after the last group of players in that round submits their scorecards. Appeals submitted after 10 minutes will not be accepted. **Appeal fee: RM1300.00 per appeal.** If the appeal is successful, the appeal fee will be refunded; if unsuccessful, the fee will not be refunded. For on-site penalties made by referees according to the "Rules of Golf," any objections must be submitted to the Tournament Director according to the provisions of Rule 20 (R&A), and the decision will be final.
